TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

Manuel Antonio National Park

Transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel to start your ride to the Manuel Antonio National Park. This national park is one of the most famous in our country due to its wide variety of flora and fauna. The park has 3 different trails that go from flat to very steep. On this tour a deeply knowledgeable nature guide will walk you through the Manuel Antonio National Park, explaining the mysteries of the rainforest. The trail you will take is flat and picturesque and loops through the park making your course about 2 miles long. Throughout your hike your guide will stop and teach you about the park's natural history, which include exhaustive descriptions of animals and plants that can be observed during the hike. Along the way, you can take pictures or just admire the view. One of the highlights of this tour is that Manuel Antonio hosts 3 of the 4 existing tropical primates (monkeys) living in Costa Rica. Halfway through the hike, you will enjoy a leisure stop at the worldwide famous Third Beach. Once there you can rest on the beach or play with the waves. This stop is about 20 minutes.

Throughout the hike it is common to see sloths, birds and reptiles as well as admire orchids, butterflies and tropical trees. Your guides are equipped with Pentax and Swarovski telescopes, so you can observe wildlife and take pictures from a unique perspective. Once the tour is over transportation will be provided and you will be taken back to your hotel. The Manuel Antonio National Park is closed on Tuesday.

Horseback Riding through the Jungle

Transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and go to the property where you will start your horseback riding tour. During the 40-minute drive to Londres - where the tour starts - your guide will give you an interesting briefing about the history of Quepos. Once you reach Londres you will set foot on a picturesque property that has bathrooms, stables, a corral and an open-air waiting area. You will receive riding instructions, safety tips and practice time, before heading out to explore the rainforest. This Manuel Antonio tour allows you to uncover the exotic secrets that lie within this secondary rainforest. The maximum altitude of this area is 600 meters (1900 ft). You will ride through the mountains without reaching the mountain top. Your horse ride lasts about 2 and half hours (roundtrip) and it will be highlighted by amazing valley views, verdant vegetation and numerous wildlife species such as birds and reptiles. At the end of the trail there is a beautiful waterfall where you will be able to rest for about 30 minutes. You can lie on the grass or take a swim or even both! After the break, you will return riding the same trail. At the end of your horseback riding tour, you will be served a delicious lunch made with local ingredients and enjoy a little conversation before heading back to your hotel. This Manuel Antonio tour does not require previous experience. The minimum age is 7 years old. The maximum weight for riders is (265 pounds).

Damas Island mangrove Kayaking

Transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and during the 20-minute drive, your guide will describe the scenery highlights. This Manuel Antonio tour allows you to explore the wonders of the unique Costa Rican mangrove ecosystem. You will set out on the Paquita river, facing an island and float along the soft currents under a verdant forest canopy. Make sure you keep your eyes wide open so you can spot the uncountable bird species, reptiles, ant eaters and white-faced monkeys. While you silently observe this amazing habitat, your guide will offer explanations about the flora and fauna found in this incomparable region. The Damas Island kayaking tour takes you through the natural canals and provides an ideal opportunity to observe many birds such as herons, kingfishers, ospreys and frigates birds. As you navigate through the brackish waters you can catch glimpses of the island as you pass beneath tunnels made naturally from tree growths. This Manuel Antonio tour takes you across the waters for approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes; lunch is arranged before or after the trip. The Damas Island kayaking tour does not require previous experience. The kayaks are available for 1 or 2 passengers. Children 6 years old and over are allowed.

Damas Island mangrove Boat

Transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and during the 20-minute drive, your guide will describe the scenery highlights. This Manuel Antonio tour allows you to navigate through the wonders of the unique Costa Rican mangrove ecosystem. You will float along the calm currents under a verdant forest canopy. Make sure you keep your eyes wide open so you can spot the uncountable bird species, reptiles, ant eaters and white-faced monkeys. While you silently observe this amazing habitat, your guide will offer explanations about the flora and fauna found in this incomparable region. The Damas Island boat trip takes you through the natural canals and provides an ideal opportunity to observe many birds such as herons, kingfishers, ospreys and frigates birds. As you navigate through the brackish waters you can catch glimpses of the island as you pass beneath tunnels made naturally from tree growths and admire this small sanctuary of nature. Lunch is served after the trip. The Damas Island boat trip does not require previous experience.

Carara National Park

Transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and drive 90 minutes to Carara National Park. This gorgeous natural sanctuary is home to approximately 48% of Costa Rica's bird species, making this tour ideal for bird watching enthusiasts. There are two possible trails to explore, each of them about 2 miles length. During your hike, the nature guide will stop to point out birds and give explanations about the different things you see along the way. Halfway through the hike you will take a 20-minute stop to rest and admire the scenery. One of the incredible highlights of the Carara national Park tour is the opportunity to see Scarlet Macaws flying overhead. After exploring

the park, you will visit the Tarcoles bridge where you can observe the largest crocodile population of Costa Rica. This is a great time to get some story-worthy snapshots, so remember to bring your camera. Once you have seen all there is to see you will return to base camp where a delicious home-style lunch awaits you. At the end of the tour, you'll be taken back to your hotel. A minimum of 4 people is required for the Carara National Park tour, or in the event that less than 4 individuals want to participate they must cover the cost equivalent to 4 adult rates.

Ocean Kayaking & Snorkeling

This Manuel Antonio tour is the perfect choice for those interested in getting wet and seeing nature! Round trip transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and go to the Quepos pier. You will paddle a kayak for approximately 2 ½ hours (roundtrip), during your nautical journey you will navigate past islands where you can observe uncountable marine birds and their nesting grounds. Halfway through your trip, you will stop at a beautiful hidden bay - Biesanz Bay - to rest and enjoy a refreshing snack. During the 30-minute stop, you can snorkel on this secluded coastline or just have a rest. Water visibility depends on the season. You are most likely to spot parrotfish, starfish, angelfish and -if you are lucky- a sea turtle or too! This challenging Manuel Antonio tour allows you to discover stunning examples of nature, above and below the ocean's surface; from pelicans to flying fish, you can see it all! Upon returning to the pier, you'll head back to base camp to enjoy a little conversation over a delicious homemade meal. Kayaks are available for 1 or 2 passengers. Minimum age is 8 years old. Sea kayaking is much easier than river kayaking; this Manuel Antonio tour does not require previous experience.

The road trip to the rafting site offers picturesque views of African palm plantations, little towns, small rivers and jungle. Your guide will gladly tell you all about the things you see along the way. Upon arriving at the put in spot, you will receive a safety talk and an opportunity to practice before getting into the river. The rafts in this Manuel Antonio tour are built

for 6 passengers and guides will travel in kayaks alongside you to ensure your safety. Savegre River delivers class 3 rapids and is filled with bends and turns of excitement. You will spend approximately 2 ½ hours in the raft taming the rapids, taking occasional stops to rest and admire some of the region's beautiful flora and fauna. Towards the end of this Manuel Antonio rafting tour, the waters become calm and easy, allowing you to take a closer look at birds flying overhead and the colorful vegetation. Your drive back to base camp will be much shorter, about 30 minutes, where you can change your clothes and have a delicious homemade meal. This river boasts class 3 rapids all year long, during dry season it can also provide some class 2 rapids. Children must be at least 8 years old.

Naranjo River White Water Rafting

Round trip transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and drive 40 minutes to town of Londres, where the river put in is located. During this scenic drive, your guide will talk about the history of the town of Quepos. Once on site - a private property where the put in is located - you will be ready to start off on your Manuel Antonio tour. The property features stables, corrals, an open-air waiting area and bathrooms. Your guide will give you some safety measurements to follow and then... you are ready to tame the rapids of the Naranjo River. The rafts are built to hold a maximum of 6 passengers. Guides will join you in kayaking to ensure your safety. Naranjo River flows through mountains, jungle gorges, farmlands and palm plantations. The river's course is steep and challenging, perfect for adventure seekers searching for an adrenaline rush. Halfway through the tour, you'll have a break where you can catch up your breath and admire the view. Towards the end of the river, the waters calm down and you can take in the sights while cruising over the last few rapids. After completing this 1 hour and 45-minute Manuel Antonio rafting tour, a tasty lunch - made with fresh local ingredients – will be served. The Naranjo River rafting tour is

El Chorro* White Water Rafting / Extreme Raft

Adventurous people visiting Manuel Antonio should not miss the chance to overcome "El Chorro", a high degree whitewater rafting trip. "El Chorro" is a Class 4 whitewater rafting trip on the upper section of the Naranjo River, about 45 minutes from the main Manuel Antonio hotel area. This whitewater rafting trip is known as a dry season Class IV, and it boosts up to Class V and frequently turns unnavigable during rainy season. Although it's a strenuous and challenging whitewater trip, rafters do not need prior rafting experience; nevertheless, they have to be in good physical condition. Since the rapids go through a very narrow gorge, it had been decided to name it "El Chorro" where the appropriate translation to English would be "jet gorge". This powerful excursion lasts around 4 hours, between the pick-up and drop-off at your hotel. It includes round trip transportation (to the main Quepos - Manuel Antonio hotel area), equipment and snacks at the end of the adventure. Children must be at least 16 years old.

Catamaran Adventure

Round trip transportation is provided and you will be picked up at your hotel and go to the Quepos pier. A guide will take you to the loading platform and help you board the catamaran. You will set sail towards the horizon and cruise over sapphire hued waves. The catamaran will chart a picturesque course departing from Quepos and gliding around the back of the Manuel Antonio National Park. Your guide will point out notable wildlife and vegetation, so be sure to have your camera ready. You will go by amazing scenarios adorned with islands, cliffs and rock formations. You can admire bird nesting grounds and marine wildlife. Beverages and snacks are available onboard, throughout the trip. After touring the coastline, your captain will set anchor at Biesanz Bay where you can snorkel or simply rest onboard. You are most likely to spot parrotfish, starfish, angelfish and if you are lucky a dolphin! During the tour you'll have a tasty barbeque lunch onboard, while admiring the lovely waterscapes. This Manuel Antonio tour does not require previous experience. Water visibility depends on the season.

Whale Watching Tour

We invite you to explore one of the most beautiful National Parks in Costa Rica, Marine National Park Ballena, located near the village of Uvita in the Pacific Coast of Costa Rica. Our Whale Watching tour gives you the opportunity to spot pilot whales and humpback whales, when these are migrating from North to during their mating season, following the warm waters of the Central Pacific Ocean. This Whale Watching Tour starts from Manuel Antonio, and it takes about 1 hour drive to the Marino Ballena National Park, along the way our naturalist guide will explain the history of our people and he will show different beaches such as Dominical, Playa Matapalo, Playa Uvita. Once on the boat and starting the tour, you will sail along the coast of the Pacific Ocean for three hours in search of whales and dolphins, going by the beautiful Roca Ballena, las Cavernas in front of Playa Ventanas y Roca Viuda y Tres Hermanas, a natural outstanding rock system. Whale sightseeing is not an exact science; therefore, we can't guarantee to spot one. However, the chances of seeing a whale are very high! A minimum of 4 people is required for the Whale Watching Tour from Manuel Antonio or Quepos Area, or if less than 4 individuals want to participate, they must cover the cost equivalent to 4 adult rates. **This tour operates from July 15th to October 15th**

Damas Island Mangrove wetlands~ fishing tour

The Damas Island is located about 20 minutes from the Manuel Antonio main hotel area and the dock is easy to access, making it suitable for all kinds of anglers.
